Green Lake Shoreline Restoration Applications

Green Lake Shoreline Restoration applications are being accepted at this time. The deadline to have all Statements of Intent turned in to Soil and Water is before the end of March 2019, so please respond early. Isanti Soil and Water has contributed to our restoration fund along with the Green Lake Improvement District's funding. Property owners will only need to contribute 25% of the cost of design, plants and labor. That 25% can be in the form of labor and also includes volunteer's labor time. It's a great program.
