This appreciation to MLR was demonstrated by giving this extra Lake Steward Sign recognition.

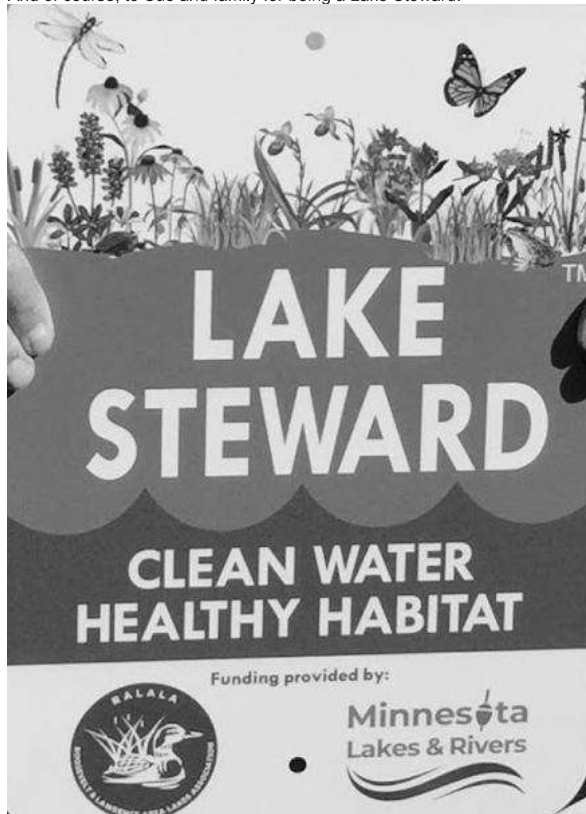
And of course, continue our donations✓
