Annual General Membership Meeting
Wyanett Town Hall Saturday, July 24, 2010

Board Members Present: Bob Duncan, Dave Dancik, Jim McLaughlin, Barb Prince, Larry Lindquist, Larry Kohout, Ken Murray
Board Member Resignation: Carlene Sargent

- I. Meeting called to order by President Bob Duncan.
- II. Motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes of the 2009 annual meeting with one revision. Approved.
- III. Weed control.
 - a. There were only 6 lake owners that responded to the process for weed control.
 - b. Need to have money refunded from weed harvester: \$1200
- IV. Update on water testing
 - a. Wyanett Creek
 - i. PH was .222, in 2005 it was .243
 - ii. Further up .134 in 2005 it was .185
 - b. North Brook
 - i. PH .247 about 2 miles upstream
 - ii. .080 at the lake compared to .118 in 2005
 - c. Last two years low rain fall, minimal flow.
 - d. Secchi about average
 - e. TSI rating – impaired
 - i. Phos, Chlor, Secchi all trend together
- V. Discussion of state funding
 - a. \$250 MM per year for clean water
 - b. Need to get water plan going so can get on the list for funds
 - c. Currently scheduled late 2016 or 17 for review.
- VI. Discussion of what can/should be done for Green Lake
 - a. 900 lakes on the impaired list
 - i. Many of those lakes are not doing water testing
 - b. Entire water shed is now being farmed due to the high crop prices
 - c. Need experts to determine what should be done: buffers
 - d. Turkey farm is watched by the PCA and are in compliance
 - i. They do spread on their fields for crops
 - ii. When last tested, no fecal matter in the water
 - iii. Their documentation is on the PCA website as compliant
 - e. Dennis H. has 1,000 dairy cows and farms 1,000 acres for feed
 - f. Plan – Ed Feiler says he can help write the plan
 - i. Mitch Nelson volunteered to assist
 - ii. We may need to hire someone to get it in the shape required to get funding.

VII. Budget and Finances

- a. After review, a motion was made to approve the budget. Second
- b. There will be a \$3,300 for the 2011 Taxes for GLID expenses
- c. Approved (attached)
- d. Invoices\ for payment
 - i. \$143 for Web Site hosting
 - ii. \$130.65 for Picnic Supplies
 - iii. Motion moved, seconded and passed to pay.

VIII. Discussion of Restoration of Wyanett Creek

- a. Discussion around dredging at the mouth of the creek to remove sediment.

IX. Board Elections

- a. Only one volunteer, Mitch Nelson
 - i. Affirmed
