

Green Lake Improvement District Annual Meeting

July 28, 2012 Wyanett Town Hall, 9 AM

1. Approval of minutes of 2011 Annual Meeting
 - Motion: Moved to approve the minutes of the previous annual meeting as presented.
 - So moved, seconded and approved.
2. Overview of the GLID
 - a. An overview was provided of the history of the GLID
3. Water Testing – Jim M.
 - a. Green Lake is impaired based on the state guidelines for the trophic index
 - i. A reading of 59 makes a lake impaired
 - b. Water quality readings have remained pretty constant for the past several year (chart shown)
 - c. Secchi readings have been in the 7 – 8 foot range
4. Isanti County Water Management Plan
 - a. Updating the written plan
 - b. Does not have the steps to improve the water quality
 - c. Green Lake is included
 - d. No money has been set aside for projects
5. Rum River Water Shed TMDL
 - a. MN Water Pollution Agency, Bonnie
 - i. Spent a day on Green Lake
 - ii. Has a copy of our study
 - iii. No recommendations at this point
 - b. Rum River is the only “wild and scenic river”
 - c. Lake Milacs is the largest water shed, Green Lake’s watershed is the second largest
 - i. Green Lake is the only lake with an outlet into the Rum River
6. Wyanett Creek Restoration
 - a. Dealt with all the agencies
 - b. Project was supposed to start on Monday, started on Sunday instead
 - i. Had to call the agencies to get someone onsite to oversee what was happening
 - c. Intention was to take out the peninsula and the debris, rocks, etc. behind it
 - i. What was requested did not happen
 - ii. DNR issues a “satisfactory” certificate and will not address the issue further
7. Board meetings throughout the rest of the year
 - a. Typically 3rd Tuesday of each month at 7:30 PM Wyanett town hall
 - b. Posted on the website and in the Princeton paper

8. Budget Review and Approval

a. The budget was reviewed

- i. Discussion ensued as to the different categories

Motion: It is moved to approve the 2013 budget as presented.

So moved, seconded and approved

- ii. No new taxes required for 2013

b. Other information

- i. The budget is audited by Isanti County each year

9. Open Discussion

a. Web Page

- i. Concern was expressed over the relevance of the website and whether it is worth while

- ii. Bob Duncan said he would work on keeping it more up to date

- iii. Cost per year is \$150

b. Home owner treatment for weeds and swimmers itch

- i. Only out to 150 feet from shore

- ii. Percentage of shoreline or up to 50 feet of shoreline max

1. Normally 2 applications are required

- iii. GLID covers the fee for the permit, \$750

Motion: Is it moved that the GLID pay the \$750 fee for the lake wide permit each year and that it will be a budget item.

So moved, seconded and approved.

10. Request for volunteers to serve on the board.
