

GLID Board Minutes: March 25, 2006

Meeting called to order at 9 AM by Jim McLaughlin

A. DNR Lake Plan

- a. Jim M. reported that we would like to use Ed Feiler to help write the plan. He will use non GLID dollars to fund the cost.

Motion: It was moved that Ed Feiler be used to assist in writing a Green Lake plan to be submitted to the foundation for funding.

B. Bruce Bomier

- a. Jim M. reported that Bruce, an environmental specialist can get an \$8,000 grant to:
 - i. Compare our lake with Spectacle Lake
 - ii. Do other exploratory work on water quality and weeks
 - iii. This will be a one time study with results later in 2006.

Motion: It was moved that the GLID accept the \$8,000 grant to study our lake and the effects of 24D on Green Lake by Bruce Bomier's company.

Motion passed.

C. Weed Plan for 2006

- a. Bob D. reported that area captains will be recruited like last year to cover all the areas of the lake. The area captains will canvas the residents as to their preference: professional herbicide, professional cutting/harvesting, take their own actions or do nothing.
- b. This information will be collected and reported to Bob Duncan to accumulate and provide to the vendors used for the professional work.
- c. All lake owners will need to fill out permit applications for their property.
- d. Discussion was held around the benefits and issues.
 - i. Those noted were that professional herbicide should be applied in two applications some weeks apart to get full coverage for the summer.
 - ii. It was also noted that the cutting and harvesting did produce some left over particles. This is how mill foil naturally spreads itself. It

is not know if this is a major issue since boating traffic has the same result.

- iii. Rollers also require an individual permit which, depending on the lake bottom, sandy may be approved or muddy may not be approved. Rollers cost around \$2500.
- e. An all lake Weed Meeting will be held on May 6 at 9 AM in the Waynett town hall.
