

GLID Board Minutes: April 14, 2007

Board Members Present: Dave Dancik, Bob Duncan, Jim McLaughlin, Larry Kohout, Mitch Nelson

Board Members Absent: Ken Murray, Barb Prince, Kevin O'Keef 1 open position

Location: Waynett Town Hall

Meeting called to order at 9 AM by Jim McLaughlin

Two lake home owners were present: Joni and Bob Jacobs

A. Lake Depth

- a. Set at current level by DNR at what they believe is the "normal depth" and is regulated by the culvert at Waynett Creek.
- b. Water level of North Brook rises by a foot with heavy rain

B. Water samples will be tested by RMB labs

C. Weed Control

- a. The GLID will get the permit for all home owners, \$750 in 2006 which was not spend because the DNR would no allow any activity
- b. Will get the instructions to the area captains including the permit document
 - i. Bob Duncan organized in 2006. Need someone to organize for 2007
 - ii. Need to recruit block captains.
- c. Every home owner will need to fill out a permit and return to their area captain
- d. We have budget for 2006 to cut the "roads" 150 feet from shore, homeowners will cut the "drive way" to the roads
- e. Expected costs for weed cutting to be \$300 per home owner
 - i. Jim M. will contact the company again that did the cutting in 2005. They were not particularly happy that we contracted with them but nothing was done in 2006. No weeds
 - ii. Jim M. will contact the herbicide company also. This did not work as well as cutting but needed two applications about 4 weeks apart vs. the one that was done. About the same cost, \$300.
- f. Send out notice to all homeowners with the newsletter with instructions
- g. The DNR has the \$3,000 program again. Jim has applied but will not get the money unless needed.

D. Lake Management Plan

- a. Being funded by the Initiative Foundation
- b. Reviewed 2 or 3 plans and they are really not much
- c. Ed Feiler is working on the GLID plan and we have a person writing using our grant money.

E. Discussion of county zoning

- a. Seem to let everything go through with out questioning the impact on the lake
- b. Jim M. has done to the meetings and there does not seem to be much we can do.
He discusses the issues but the requests are improved anyway
