1. Review of Lake Management Plan with Mary Bayerl
  - Copies of the plan provided
  - Need to keep track of time to use as part of the In Kind portion of the plan implementation
  - Sec 2.11 – have enough data for impairments, Need to take more readings on the streams
    - a. More regular, stream flow after rain events and
  - Sec 2.13 – Contact Jamie S. about rainfall, etc. He can do the work for us at a cost.
  - Sec 2.15 – GLID will end up paying
  - Sec 2.16 – Best practices, septic pumping intervals, put link on the website
  - Sec 2.26 – we could write a request for grant for signs and to have inspections at the boat launch.
    - a. General problem is that the coverage would be very spotty based on the landing being used every day but the checking would only be random
  - Potential projects
    - a. Holding pond on upstream on Wyanett Creek
    - b. Barrier and rain gardens to stop sediment from going into the lake on Feldspar
2. PIKM – 5 county lake associations
  - Meet one per quarter
  - Affiliated with COLA and have a lobbyist fir water quality at the state
  - Meet 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday of every other month in Braham
    - 15 at last meeting, 8 lakes represented all with the same issues
3. BWSR Conservation Grant due by June 15<sup>th</sup>, up to %150,000 in Grants available
4. Wyanett Creek is still an issue
  - Regulating vegetation plantings on the peninsula
  - What are the rules with respect to ownership of the creek by land owners on either side
  - What will actually work, vegetation or holding ponds
